The John Player Challenge Trophy Competitors 1970

ARTHUR ASHE

Born Richmond, Virginia. Formerly Lieutenant in the United States Military Academy. American Davis Cup Squad 1968. Won first American open 1968. Number 2 in the World to Laver in 1968. He won Australian open this year, 1970. Ranked No. 1 in America. Wimbledon semi-finalist, lost to Laver. Ranked No. 6 in the world currently and he helped America retain Davis Cup last year.

BOB LUTZ

Born 29th August, 1947, Lancaster Pa, Los Angeles. Wears contact lenses. Attended University South California. 1965 - United States of America National Junior Championship. 1966 - With Stan Smith won the United States National Indoor doubles Championship. Quarter finalist at Wimbledon in the mixed doubles with Rosemary Casals. 1968 - Lost in final of United States Amateur Championships to Arthur Ashe. Won United States Amateur and open double Championships with Stan Smith. Runner up with Bob Everitt in the British covered court Championships and won the doubles with Stan Smith. 1969 - Ranked 5th in the United States. Lost in quarter finals at Wimbledon to Arthur Ashe and reached the quarter finals of the Wimbledon doubles championships with Stan Smith. In the Davis Cup doubles with Stan Smith beat Tiriac and Nastase of Rumania.

BOB HEWITT

Born Sydney 12th January, 1940. Never played for Australia in the Davis Cup and when he married a South African girl he played for South Africa and he is their No. 1 Davis Cup player. He has won doubles at Wimbledon three times and he was the first winner of the Dewar Cup. That was 1½ years ago. 1969 runner-up British Hard Court Championships and he has just been runner-up in the Hard Court Championships one week ago to Cox. He won both his singles for South Africa against Britain at Bristol last year in the Davis Cup, although Britain won the tie.

CHARLIE PASARELL

Puerto Rican. Born San Juan 12th February, 1944. He was the American National Indoor Champion 1966 and 1967. Beat Santana in the 1st round at Wimbledon in 1967. 1969 ranked 7th in America and a member of their Davis Cup Squad. Lost in an epic at Wimbledon last year to Gonzalez after leading two sets to love.
